

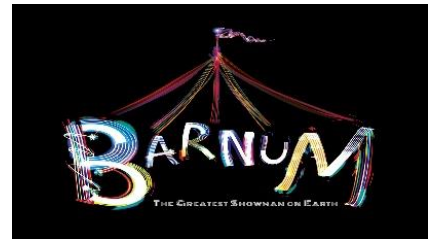

TECH REHEARSAL is next Saturday, 10/19 from 9:00AM to 4:00PM. The long day will be broken up as follows.

11:00AM – Choreography Fixes

12:00PM – Lunch *(Bring your own lunch and water bottle. The production team will supply an afternoon snack and extra water for the long day.)*

1:00PM – Full Run with orchestra *(no costumes or make-up)*
