FORTRESS OF FANDOM TECH WEEK

HAIR-- Girls, should have their hair pulled back from the face and face shield for all dress rehearsals and performances.

MAKE-UP -- Boys: Arrive for all dress rehearsals and performances wearing foundation, light blush

Girls: Bring/keep any make-up in your own bin, CLEARLY MARKED. We cannot share anything. You must have your own foundation, blush, eyeliner, mascara, Eye shadow, and lipstick

COSTUMING/CHANGES: Several members have some quicker costume changes. If you have a costume change that requires the actual removal of clothing, vs just adding a cape or different hat, you should come prepared to do so modestly backstage as necessary. **This means**:

GIRLS: Wear a pair of bike/spandex shorts and camisole or a leo and tights at all times.

BOYS: Wear bike shorts and a tank top or t-shirt under your costume at all times.

PLEASE NOTE: These items are not suitable for walking around - only for quick changes.

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT: In an effort to keep each rehearsal and show as organized and stress-less as possible, we will have a very specific procedure to check in and out. This will allow us to come in each evening, ready to go, with as few complications as possible. When you arrive, you must check in as normal, then proceed to your dressing room. At the end of each dress rehearsal and show, you need to return any costume pieces to the dressing room (NEATLY HUNG). You will need to return any prop used to their designated spot on the prop table. Then, once said items are properly returned, you will need to sign out with Logan as usual.

12:30 - ALL CAST ARRIVE 1:00- MIC CHECK 1:30- ALL CAST IN UPPER ROOM *Once you are ready in costume, with hair and make-up prepped, please stay in Upper Room.

STRIKE AND CAST PARTY: After the final show, all cast members are **required** to stay and assist with Strike. Logan and Evie will assign tasks, so everything can be completed in a timely fashion and we can get on with the CAST PARTY!

VOLUNTEER: Parents, we cannot put this show on without your help! Please keep your eye out for opportunities to sign up to help with rehearsals, shows and cast party.

BACKSTAGE:

- *No food! Only water in non-breakable containers will be allowed behind the curtains.
- *Please keep the wings clear when not waiting to go on stage
- *PLEASE be silent backstage!
- *Keep your hands to yourself. This includes not only away from other people, but also off of props, curtains, ropes and anything else that you are not assigned to be touching.
- *Walking feet only. Please do not climb. No gathering or roughhousing on or near stairs. It is our desire to keep everyone as safe as possible.
 - *Only use backstage restrooms.
 - *No eating while wearing microphones.
