WORK DAY

We'll be pulling props and small set pieces, painting, finishing up costumes, and various other things. Anyone who needs to add to their grass skirts or paint their costumes can do so on Saturday.

Probably the most major project will be creating the sail for the boat, now that it has been built. The sail will need to be semi-functional, as it raises and lowers throughout the show, which I imagine will require some kind of pulley system. For this task, we are requesting the aid of any parents (or other family members) with some technical knowledge who would have some idea of how to achieve this. Likewise, any volunteers who would like to help with any of the other tasks mentioned are also welcome. As always, any volunteers will require clearances, as can be obtained here.

Most other technical needs are covered, but we are still looking for a canoe for when Moana initially attempts to leave the island. It needs to fit one teenager and two children (in terms of size; I know you're a teenager, Morgan) for about a minute-and-a-half (so they don't necessarily need to be comfortable) and would either need to look wooden or be able to be painted brown, but would not need to actually be seaworthy. If anyone would have any leads on where we could obtain/borrow one, it would be appreciated, as I am striking out.
