Earlier we sent a quick email with very little details outside of the fact that this evening's performance of Peter Panic was cancelled. We did not want to wait to alert you of this decision until we had gathered all the information and had a solid game plan in place. We now have a game plan and would like to provide you with additional details.

We continue to closely monitor federal, state, and local government guidance regarding the spread of coronavirus. This afternoon, Governor Wolf made the decision to close all PA schools until March 30th. At that time our Coronavirus Response Team met to discuss the situation. As we took into consideration the safety of our students, families and volunteers, we decided to **CLOSE this weekend's performances of Peter Panic.**

The show will go on, but out of an abundance of caution, the only audience members for our live performance will be the stuffed animal friends of our students!

We understand that our audience members were looking forward to seeing our young performers on the stage this weekend so we will be working with a professional filmmaker to capture the performance for each of our ticket holders.

We continue to take every precaution and our student's safety is of utmost concern to us. The rest of the weekend will flow like this:

Saturday:

- Call Time 5:30PM
- CLOSED Performance recorded

Sunday:

- Call Time 12:30
- CLOSED Performance with additional recording, if needed.
- Strike & Cast Party
- Students will be picked up at 4:30PM

Please remember:

1. Students are welcome to bring their favorite stuffed animal, etc. to be part of the audience.
2. Only production team members will be permitted in the auditorium.
3. We will continue to reinforce personal hygiene with the students, require frequent handwashing and provide hand sanitizer.
